

THE DOUGLAS ORANE SCHOLARSHIP IN SCIENCE, TECHNOLOGY OR ENGINEERING PROVIDED BY THE GraceKennedy FOUNDATION

CONDITIONS OF AWARD OF SCHOLARSHIP

1.0 AWARD

The award shall be known as THE DOUGLAS ORANE SCHOLARSHIP

2.0 ANNUAL SCHOLARSHIP TO A STUDENT ATTENDING <u>ANY ONE</u> OF THE FOLLOWING TERTIARY INSTITUTIONS:

- The University of the West Indies
- University of Technology, Jamaica
- Northern Caribbean University
- 2.1 The scholarship will be open to all **undergraduate** applicants who have met the entry requirements of The University of the West Indies or University of Technology Jamaica or Northern Caribbean University and the Faculty to which they request admission, and who qualify under the terms and conditions stated below.
- 2.2 The following field of study/faculty will **not** be considered for this scholarship:
 - Medicine & Nursing, Physiotherapy, UWI
 - Actuarial Science, UWI
 - Health & Applied Sciences, UTECH
 - Nursing, NCU

3.0 TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The applicant shall:—

- 3.1 Be a Jamaican citizen,
- 3.2 On the first day of May in the year of the application, the candidate shall not be over the age of twenty-five (25) years,
- 3.3 Have completed the application for admission as a **fulltime** student to one (1) of the institutions listed in **2.0** and, at the time of interview, have been accepted for entry,
- 3.4 Have a 3.0 gpa or above,
- 3.5 Be a person of good character, displaying leadership qualities, manifesting creative energy and curiosity and consistent involvement in social/community activities,

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- 3.6 Have completed and submitted the **Douglas Orane Scholarship** application form by **July 15**,
- 3.7 Be expected to serve/work in Jamaica for a period of three (3) years upon completion of his/her studies,
- 3.8 Have given good and sufficient evidence that the requirements specified in 3.1 to 3.7 above have been satisfied.

4.0 INSTRUCTIONS

- 4.1 It is the responsibility of the applicant to submit all outstanding academic grades (CAPE/ Semester grades) received after July 15. These grades are to be emailed to **gkfoundation@gkco.com**.
- 4.2 Supporting documents to be submitted with the application form:
 - (i) A reference from a Senior Teacher/Principal at your High School or one of your Lecturers from the Faculty (if currently enrolled in the institution)
 - (ii) Academic Record: Certified copies of your CSEC, CAPE & University grades.
 - (iii) Copy of your birth certificate
 - (iv) Statement about your career goals, leadership abilities, social & community involvement. Share life examples of your creative energy and curiosity (not to exceed 500 words).
- (v) Acceptance letter from the University

5.0 **REGULATIONS**

- 5.1 Any candidate to whom this Scholarship is awarded shall not simultaneously hold:—
 - (i) Any other substantial award without the permission of the Donor; or
 - (ii) Any award which would interfere with the regulations governing this Scholarship.
- 5.2 The scholarship is valued at JA\$400,000/annum for a maximum period of four consecutive (4) years.
- 5.3 The award is subject to an annual review of your academic performance, conduct and participation in social/community activities.

- 5.4 The Scholarship is valid for the academic year immediately following the offer of the award and cannot be deferred for any reason.
- 5.5 With respect to **The Douglas Orane Scholarship**, the following shall apply:
 - (a) The holder of the Scholarship is required to pursue the course of study for which the award is granted. An alteration of that course of study may not be made without the Donor's prior approval and failure to comply with this may lead to the withdrawal of the Scholarship.
 - (b) The instalments in which the Scholarship will be paid, shall be determined by the Donor at the time of the award. The Donor may make changes to the value and the instalments as a result of any approved alterations in the course of study by the holder.
- 5.6 The Scholarship shall be tenable at The University of the West Indies or the University of Technology, Jamaica, or Northern Caribbean University.
- 5.7 The donor shall appoint a selection panel comprising at least the following: one representative appointed by the Orane family, and two representatives from the GraceKennedy Foundation, one of whom shall be the Chairman of the panel.

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
